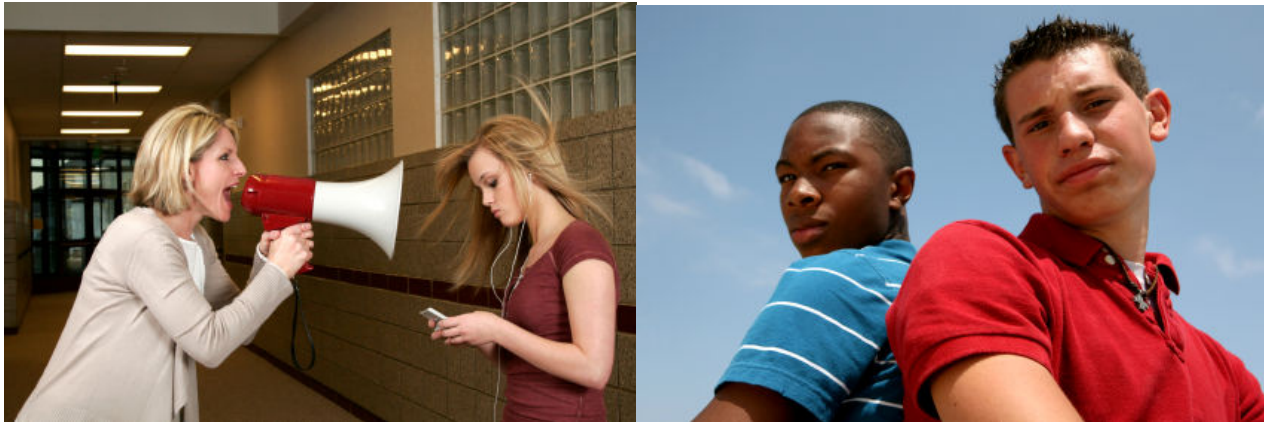


The Best of Times, The Worst of Times: Understanding and Parenting Adolescents
